Acknowledge and face philanthropy's role in the current disregard, disrespect, and devaluation of Black bodies, culture, and language.



Diversify your Board and Senior Leadership positions. Empower those individuals to assert their position of authority. All decision-making levels within your organization should reflect a commitment to equity.



Build relationships with the communities you are aiming to support. Most importantly, compensate community members for their intellectual property and labor to support your efforts.



Examine the application process of current grant opportunities and **implement a blind proposal and site visits** into the application process.



Intentionally invest in solutions and opportunities to support self-care strategies for Black Women leaders. This intentional investment in restorative practices is just one of the many components for healing past transgressions.
